- 3. On a sheet of flipchart paper, sketch and colour the alien. Include and label the special features you have listed in the table above.
- 4. Display your group's illustration and give a five-minute presentation about your alien. Invite your class to ask your group questions and make comments. Compare and contrast your group's alien with those concocted by the other groups.
