The group of people in need of help.	About 63 million refugees worldwide, many of them children. Many live under very harsh conditions.
Their needs.	Food, shelter, and clothing to protect them from severe climatic conditions, clean drinking water, etc. Even something like a rechargeable torchlight goes a long way to provide security.
