a.	In comic books and movies, most superheroes are men. Wonder Woman is one of the few female superheroes. Why do you think this has been the case?
b.	Some adults think that certain jobs are only for men, while other jobs are only for women. This is not a fair way of hiring. What are your group's thoughts about this?
C.	What advice does your group have for big companies when they hire men and women for various jobs?
d.	By the time you grow up, what changes would your group like to see in society's attitudes about men and women at work?
