

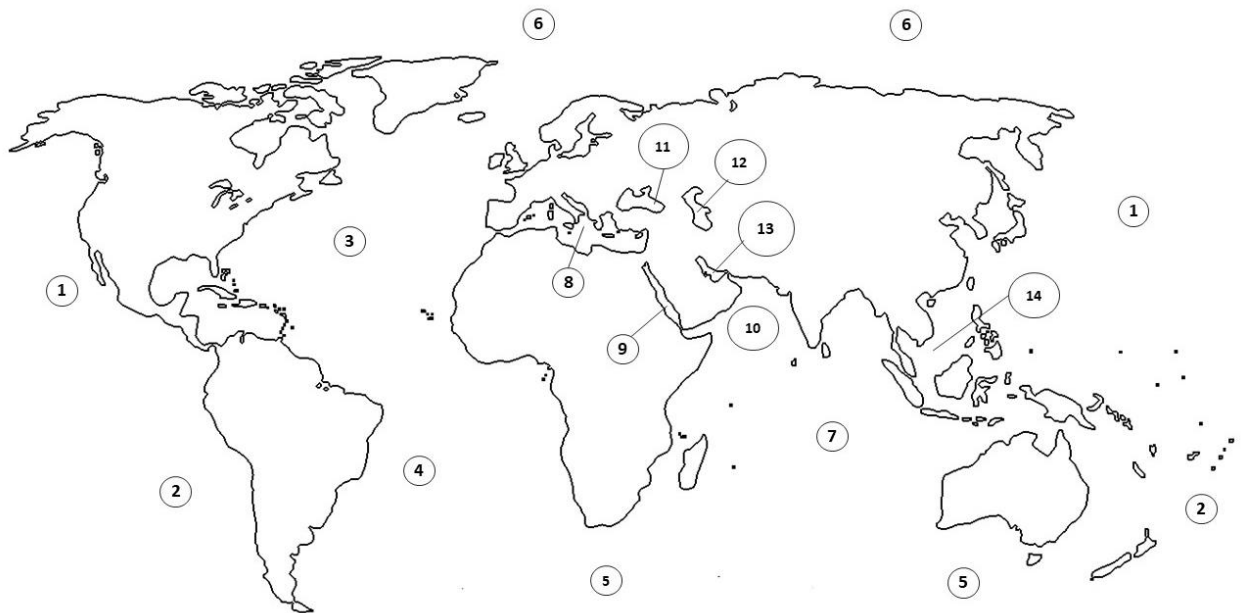
Where on Earth?
