



## STATEMENT SHEET FOR GAME REFEREE ONLY

### Game: Have A Heart

1. The kidney is an organ that can be donated by a living or deceased donor. (TRUE)
2. The heart is an organ that can be transplanted. (TRUE)
3. The liver is an organ that cannot be transplanted. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: The liver is an organ that can be transplanted.
4. When someone donates an eye, the whole eye is removed and transplanted. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: Only the cornea and not the whole eye is removed. (The cornea is only about the size and shape of a contact lens.)
5. The lung is an organ that cannot be transplanted. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: The lung is an organ that can be transplanted.
6. The trachea or windpipe is currently not an organ that can be transplanted. Scientists are studying how to do it. (FALSE)  
  
CORRECTION: The trachea or windpipe is an organ that can be transplanted.
7. Bones can be transplanted. (TRUE)
8. The skin cannot be transplanted. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: The skin can be transplanted. (Donor skin is an effective treatment option for burn patients.)
9. Up to seven lives can be saved with organs from a single donor. (TRUE)
10. The buying and selling of organs is legal in Singapore. If you do not want to donate your organs, you can sell them to patients who need it. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: The buying or selling of organs is illegal in Singapore.
11. You have to be related to the patient in order to donate your organs. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: You do not have to be related to the patient in order to donate your organs.

12. The average waiting time for a kidney transplant is 9 years because of a shortage of donors. (TRUE)
13. You cannot choose who receives your organs, or deny anyone from receiving them. (TRUE)
14. For organ donation by a deceased person, the donor's family will have to pay the hospital bill for any organ removal. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: (Donation is a gift.) The donor's family will not have to pay the hospital bill for any organ removal from the deceased donor.
15. Many major religions in Singapore do not support organ donation. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: (Organ donation is considered a gift and an act of charity.) Most major religions in Singapore support organ and tissue donation.
16. The brain is one of the organs that can be transplanted. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: The brain is not one of the organs that can be transplanted.
17. Organ donors can choose to donate their whole body after death for organ transplant or for medical research and education. (TRUE)
18. The current high demand for organs is not expected to increase in the future. (FALSE)  
CORRECTION: The demand for organs is expected to increase in the future.
