

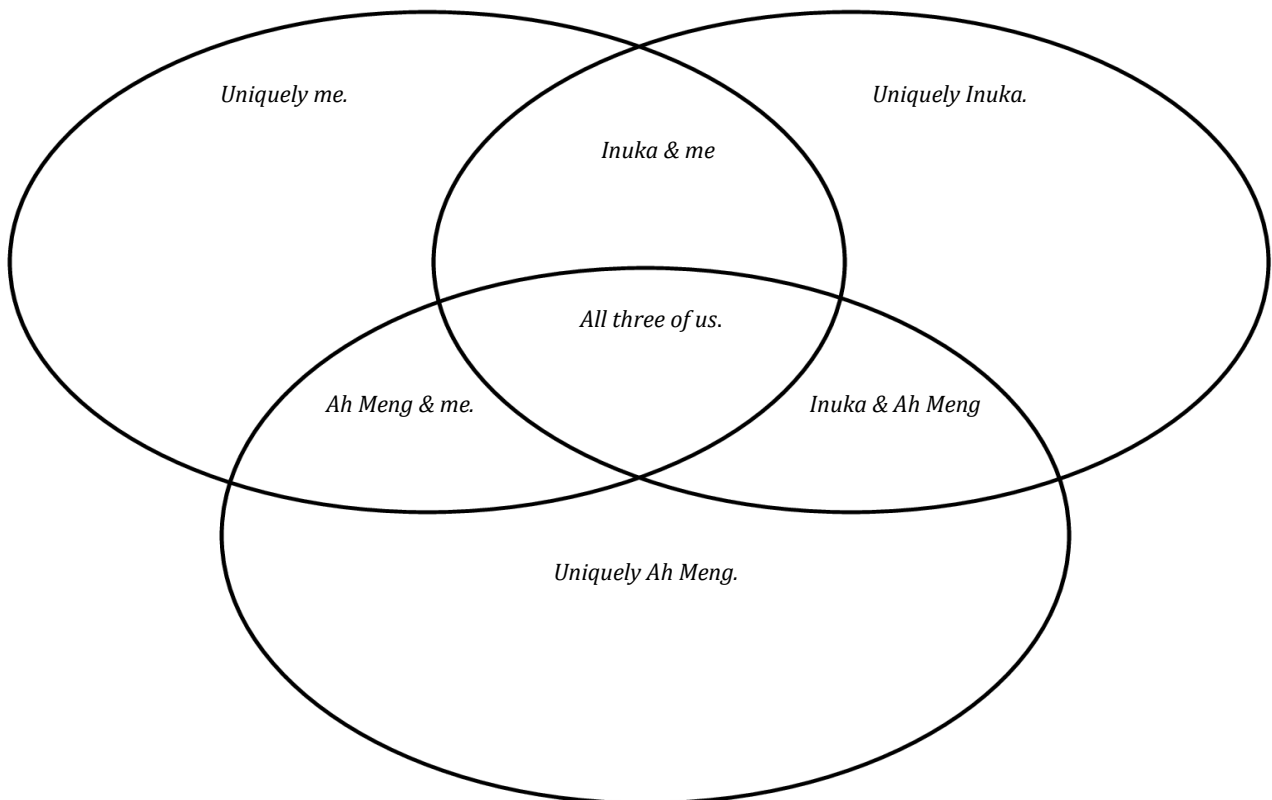
Inuka, Ah Meng, and Me

An activity of "Farewell, Inuka"

Inuka was one of the most loved mammals at the Singapore Zoo. Another lovable mammal was an orangutan named Ah Meng. Polar bears and orangutans do not look alike but have similarities as mammals. Humans look a little more like orangutans than polar bears. But, we are also very different from them. Follow the steps below to examine the similarities and differences.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read "**Farewell, Inuka**" (page 10-11, *What's Up* May issue) to learn a little about polar bears. Working in pairs, gather as much information as you can about polar bears and orangutans from the library and internet.
2. Discuss with your partner what you have in common with Inuka and Ah Meng. You may include your personality, likes and dislikes, and even appearance. In point form, plug these commonalities as well as differences in the correct sections of the Venn circles below.



3. **SHARE** your Venn diagram with your class. Talk about what this activity meant to you.
