Creative Writing: A Potato Farmer's Story

An extension of "Bridges big and beautiful"



Read "**Bridges big and beautiful**" (page 16-17, *What's Up* September 2018). Recall this quote from potato farmer Liu Jia En in the article:

"We used to walk on mountain paths from [our province] to the other side ... It took over an hour to go down and three or four hours to climb up. We spent a whole day getting home carrying 30–40kg of potatoes. Now, it's a short walk of only 10–20 minutes!"
