An extension of "Spotting racial discrimination"

Read "**Spotting racial discrimination**" (page 15, *What's Up* October 2018). Six examples of racial discrimination are given in the article. It is easy to see what is going wrong. But, making it right is harder. A good first step is to think about what needs to change. Try doing this as a whole class. On your whiteboard, draw the following. Then, brainstorm about each situation. You will need a discussion leader to encourage everyone to share, and a scribe to jot down key points in the boxes on the board.
