Fundraising Campaign Speech

An activity of "Anak Krakatau triggers tsunami"

Read "Anak Krakatau triggers tsunami" (page 11, What's Up January 2019).

The survivors of the tsunami need your help. They need more medical and food supplies. Instead of old clothes and food items, humanitarian aid agencies are asking for cash donations that they can use to help the survivors. They need to raise more money.

Healing Hands, a humanitarian group, has approached your school to help them raise funds for their campaign. Imagine that you and your friends have volunteered to work with Healing Hands. As part of the project, you are to give a short presentation to your school, encouraging others to donate money to help the tsunami survivors.

In small groups:

- 1. Discuss why you think these aid agencies want people to donate money instead of old clothes or food items.
- 2. Brainstorm: What are some ways in which your group can raise money for the tsunami survivors?
- 3. Write a speech encouraging your schoolmates to donate to this cause.
- 4. Choose a presenter who will present your group's speech to the class.
- 5. Conduct a whole-class session, with every group's presenter speaking to the class.
