An extension of several What's Up stories

In every issue of *What's Up*, you will find stories about people in different parts of the world. At first glance, their lives appear to have little in common. Here is an activity calling for some guesstimates about happiness.

1. FORM ten groups within your class. PICK one of the following for each group, with no two groups getting the same person.
