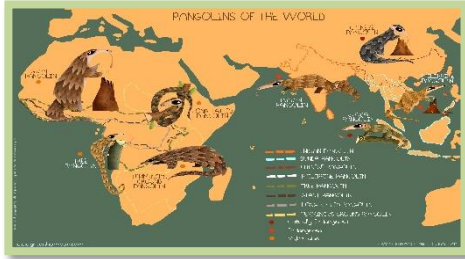


Poster: Save the Pangolin!

An extension of "Saving the pangolin"



Read **"Saving the pangolin"** (pages 12-13, *What's Up* April 2019). Zoom in on "Pangolins of the World" by artist Rohan Chakravarty on page 13. This is an example of a poster — it has many facts to educate the public about pangolins.

Now, it is your turn to make your very own poster about pangolins in South East Asia. Unlike you and your classmates, there are many people out there who do not know much about the threats that pangolins face. Your poster can be much simpler than Mr Chakravarty's.

For this activity, you will need:

A2 or A3 poster paper Markers, crayons, oil pastels or poster paints

In pairs, create a very attractive poster to encourage the world to save pangolins from becoming extinct. Your poster should:

- spread awareness about the pangolin and its plight
- urge viewers to do their part to protect the species
- use information from the article.

Use the space below and the back of this worksheet to brainstorm and sketch a draft of your poster. When you are ready, begin work on your actual poster using your A2 or A3 poster paper.
