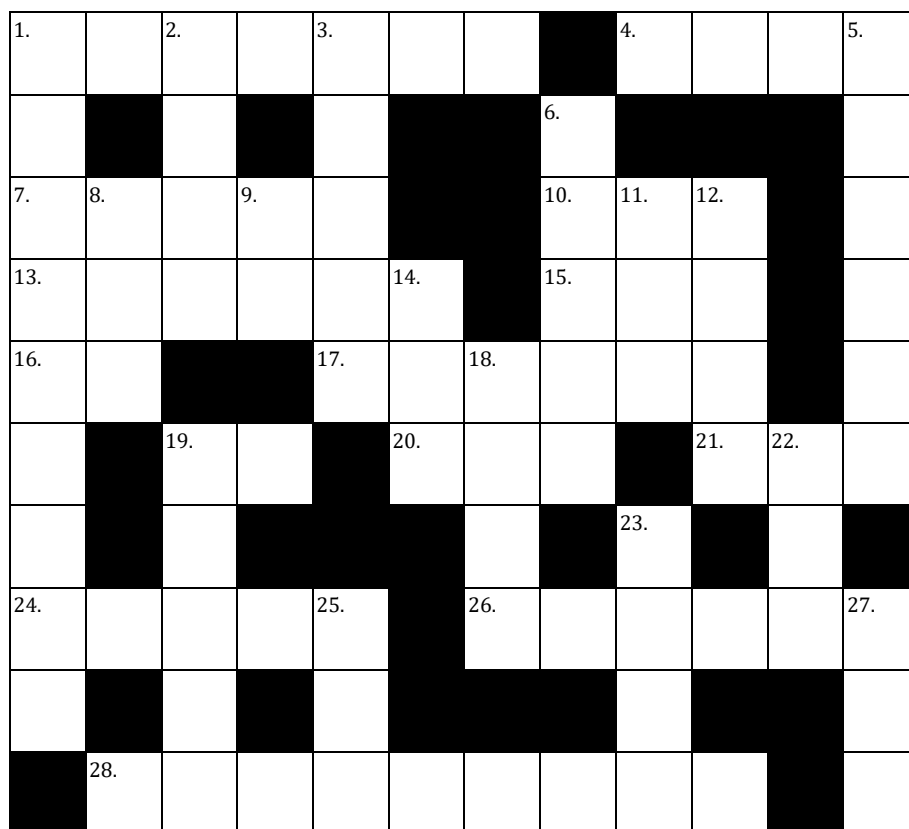


Diversity Crossword
