## Know, Want, Learn

*An activity of "Postponing the Tokyo Olympics is a big disappointment"*

Do you find it difficult to understand a reading passage sometimes? Recalling what you already know about the topic is one way to make it easier. This is the "Know, Want, Learn" strategy.
