## Your Gestalt Power

An activity of "US First Lady is a teacher first"

Jill Biden, a teacher, is now also the First Lady of the United States. Read "**US First Lady is a teacher first**" (page 11, *What's Up* March 2021) to learn more about this inspiring person.
