

Design a Calligram T-shirt

An activity of "No More Tricks!"

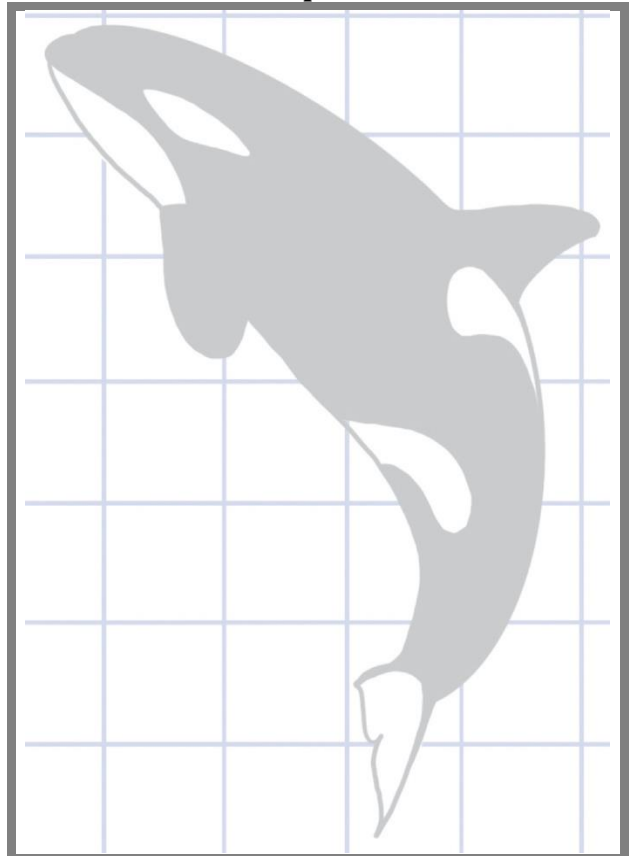


Within the orca shapes below, create two calligrams to show the difference between a free orca and a captive orca. If you need more space, use a fresh sheet of paper.
