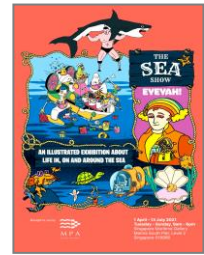
## 1. PLAN THE LEARNING JOURNEY
