In this assignment, you will design a poster to convince your family members to use less plastic. Your poster should give clear information. Your message must have impact.

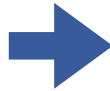
1. Answer the questions below to help draft your message. Jot down your thoughts in point form.

b) Are the containers, and whatever else they give you, eco-friendly? What can you use instead?

c) Where else do you see single-use plastics being used every day?



d) Do you really need these single-use plastics?

e) What can you do/use instead?

f) Why is using so much plastic a bad thing?

g) Can you think of a catchy slogan to help others remember your message? (e.g. *Reduce, Reuse, Recycle*)

h) What are some images you can use in your poster?

i) What type of paper, art supplies, and other materials will you need to make your poster?
