1. **Read** about Water Wally and Sally at the PUB's webpage about them.

2. **Watch** the video, "Dear Water Sally"

3. **Guess** what the storyline is. You will notice that there is background music but no words. So, to figure out what is happening, follow the scenes as you read Wally's letter. Jot down the main points of the story.
4. **Compose** a voice-over narration for this video. This means that two or three of you would be the storytellers while the video is playing.
5. **Perform** your voice-over storytelling for younger children at school or at home.
6. **Reflect** in your group what it felt like to step into the world of Water Wally and Sally for a little while.
