Read "Singapore is working towards net-zero emissions" (page 6, *What's Up* March 2022). There are other exciting efforts to take care of our environment. 1. IN YOUR GROUP — Watch your group's video. Prepare for your group's role. If your group is introducing the video, discuss how you will get your class eager to watch it. If your group is the discussion leader, prepare four questions that will encourage your classmates to share their thoughts and feelings about sea-level rise.

2. AS A WHOLE CLASS — Group 1a introduces Episode 1. The class watches the video. Then, Group 1b facilitates the discussion using its four questions as conversation starters. Group 1b wraps up the discussion and thanks everyone for taking part. Then, go on to Episodes 2 and 3 using this format.
