Grow Your Own Spring Onions

An activity of "A snapshot of Shanghai under lockdown"

2. Track the growth of one onion in Weeks 2, 4, and 6 by measuring the height of the leaves and sketching what you see in the table below.

3. When the leaves are tall enough, you may snip off two or three leaves whenever you want to add them to your meal. Use a pair of scissors to cut them into little rings and sprinkle them on your food.

Note: The green shoots are called "green onions", "spring onions", or "leeks".
