Statement	Animal
1. These tiny but terrifying fish have earned a reputation reflected in their name, which translates to "tooth fish".	
2. Weighing up to 120kg, these felines are excellent swimmers and can cross large rivers.	
3. These slithery river dwellers can generate up to 500 volts of electricity.	
4. These rare animals use unique sonar beams to navigate underwater trees and branches in the dark.	
5. The largest of its kind in the world, they can measure up to 5 metres long and weigh up to 70kg.	
6. They work together in family groups to hunt and catch fish.	
7. These charismatic creatures attract people to gather and celebrate a festival in their name.	
8. Though small, these fish can bite with a force that is three times their body weight.	
9. They are covered in circular markings called rosettes.	
10. A distant cousin of our local species, these can measure up to two metres long.
