## Human Versus Elephant

An activity of "Elephants' best friend".

Read "Elephants' best friend" (page 24–25, *What's Up* February 2023). Binod Bora rescues elephants and other wild animals in Assam. His work is helping both the local villagers and wild elephants to live happily side by side.

To be good to wild animals and the local people, Mr Bora imagines what each side may be thinking and feeling. He then talks to people about how to solve the problems. Try to do this yourself — imagine the thoughts and feelings of Mr Bora, the villagers, and the elephants.
