Writing Profiles

An activity of "Artist gone wild" and "Meet the tree climbers".

The story "Meet the tree climbers" (page 24-25, *What's Up* June 2023) is a profile of Yu Yan Ling, a professional tree climber. A profile is a written portrait of a person. It is meant to be informative, giving the reader an idea of what the person is like through a combination of facts, stories, and quotes. Let's take a closer look at the story.

PART A: Read and reflect

Read "Meet the tree climbers" and answer the following questions.

1) What makes Ms Yu interestingly different from other people?

2) How has Ms Yu or her work made an impact on other people?

3) Read the quotes said by Ms Yu and highlight your favourite one. What does the quote reveal about her character and personality?

4) What is something you have learnt after reading the story? Did you enjoy reading the story? Why or why not?

PART B: Outline and write

Imagine you are the writer of "Meet the tree climbers". Here are some points that you want to address in your story.

- What obstacles did Ms Yu face while learning or working?
- What is Ms Yu known for?
- What drives Ms Yu to do her work?
- An anecdote to introduce her work or a personal "motto".
- What are some observations Ms Yu has about her line of work?
- A great quote to end the story with.
- How did Ms Yu become interested in her line of work?
- A memorable moment or event Ms Yu has.
