*An activity of "A special encounter".*


Read "A special encounter" (pages 18–19, *What's Up* August 2023). Visitors to Gunung Leuser National Park can play their part in the preservation of its flora and fauna by observing forest etiquette. If you were a forest ranger, what would you tell the park's visitors to do?

1. Design a poster to inform visitors of the dos and don'ts when trekking Gunung Leuser. Many of your points can be extracted from the *What's Up* article.

Tips for creating your poster:

- Have a brief title and write it big.
- Write short, clear rules such as "Do not litter" so that even kids will understand them.
- Start each rule with words such as "always", "no", "never", and "keep".
- Illustrate your poster using bright, bold colours.
