






# DIY Cut Paper Art

*An activity of "Cut paper art: a new way of enjoying watercolours"*

Were you amazed by Sarah Suplina's paper art in "**Cut paper art: a new way of enjoying watercolours**" (page 20–21, *What's Up* September 2023)? Try your hand at a much simpler type of cut paper art yourself.

**Items needed:** a square piece of paper, a pair of scissors.

## Steps

<p>1. Start with a square piece of paper.</p> 	<p>2. Fold it in half to make a triangle.</p> 	<p>3. Fold it again in half to get a quarter of the original size.</p> 
<p>4. Using the scissors, snip any designs you would like on the edges of your little triangle, something like this.</p> 	<p>5. Unfold the triangle to get your master piece!</p> 	

6. Now that you have tried your hand at it, go on to make more complex and intricate designs by cutting deeper and varying the shapes more.

*Cut paper art of this kind can be a very relaxing hobby to enjoy whenever you need a break from preparing for your exams.*
