DIY Cut Paper Art

1. Start with a square piece of paper.	2. Fold it in half to make a triangle.	3. Fold it again in half to get a quarter of the original size.
4. Using the scissors, snip any designs you would like on the edges of your little triangle, something like this.	5. Unfold the triangle to get your master piece!	

6. Now that you have tried your hand at it, go on to make more complex and intricate designs by cutting deeper and varying the shapes more.

Cut paper art of this kind can be a very relaxing hobby to enjoy whenever you need a break from preparing for your exams.
