Labour Day Bingo

An activity of "Tying up loose ends with love"

The story "Tying up loose ends with love" (page 18, *What's Up* April 2024) shows us how thoughtful acts of kindness can make a difference. With Labour Day coming up on 1 May, how can you show kindness to adults working in your school?

- 1) As a class, brainstorm as many simple ways a student can show kindness to adults at school. All that you list should be doable without sending any money. Write these possible acts of kindness on your classroom whiteboard.
- 2) On your own, select 16 items from the class list. Plug them into this ↓ Bingo grid in any order you like. Each student's Bingo grid will be unique!
- 3) Over two weeks, carry out what is in your Bingo grid. Record the date and the name of the person receiving your kind act in the relevant cell. Do your selected tasks in any order.
- 4) You score a "BINGO" when you have completed four boxes in a row (horizontal, vertical or diagonal). Try to score as many BINGOs as possible!
