

A-Z Pangolin Exhibition

An activity of "Prehistoric, armoured pangolins are the world's most hunted animals".

1. Read the article "Prehistoric, armoured pangolins are the world's most hunted animals" (page 18-19, *What's Up* August 2024). Divide your class into seven groups. Each group gets a different set of three or four consecutive letters of the alphabet (e.g. D, E, & F for one group and G, H, I, & J for the next group).
2. Based on the article and your own readings, list pangolin-related terms for each of your group's three letters (e.g. A for Armour). For A and B, do not repeat the examples below.
