Your front cover should include:

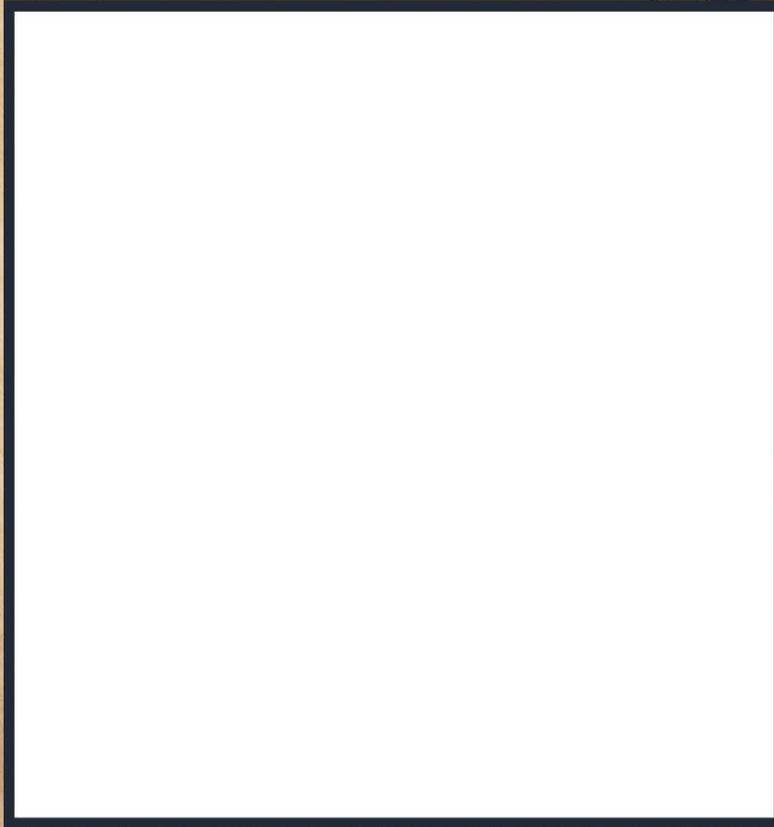
- A band name (try to make it meaningful or symbolic)

Your back cover should include:

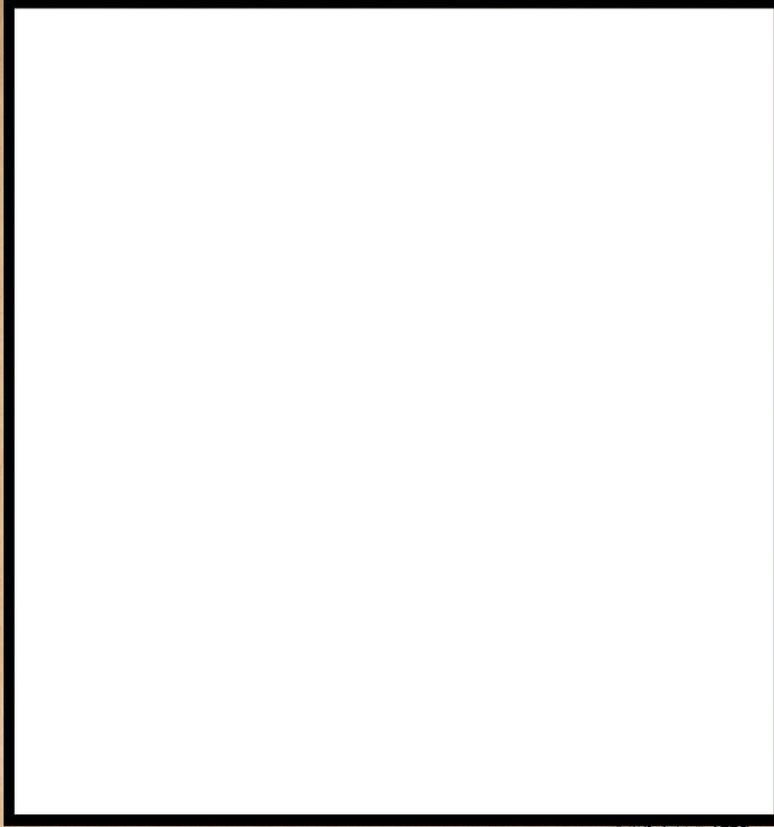
- Two or three sentences about your band's mission
