Read "Singapore opens a new national space agency" (page 12, *What's Up* March 2026). IN PAIRS

1. Brainstorm about the artwork for the card. Sketch any images that you associate with space projects. To get started, browse through the pictures on pages 10 to 12 of *What's Up* March 2026.

2. Compose a message from the two of you. Here are some examples of message starters for such a card.

- *Congrats on your launch of ...*
- *May your new space agency be ...*
- *We hope that NSAS will*
- *Three cheers for NSAS for ...*

Based on the *What's Up* article, decide which part of the NSAS's work you would like to highlight. Pick the one you find most exciting and draft your wishes for that part of the agency. Otherwise, you may also make your wishes apply to the whole agency and all the work it is going to do.

3. Use a sheet of A3 poster paper for your card. Write a main heading for the card (e.g. "Congrats, NSAS!"). For the next step, you can either have one student be the artist or have everyone contributing. Fill the poster with your collective artwork and messages. Make the poster as attractive as possible! Have a byline at the bottom indicating your class and school.
4. Send the card by post to *What's Up* (see page 28 for the office address) and our team will send it to NSAS, along with cards from all the other classes that do this activity. Imagine what a pleasant surprise your greetings will be to the NSAS team!
